Hair	<ul> <li>All hair and facial hair should be neatly groomed with respect to cultural norms.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>All hair should be neatly groomed with respect to cultural norms.</li> </ul>
Jackets and Sweaters	<ul> <li>Students are encouraged to wear their official Drew Senior Academy blazer every day and may be required to wear it for particular events. Students may also wear the following:         <ul> <li>Outerwear purchased from Flynn O'Hara Uniforms, specifically: the V-Neck Sweater, Cardigan Sweater, the V-Neck Pullover Sweater Vest and the Polar Fleece Zip Front Jacket</li> <li>Official Drew letterman jackets purchased from Creative Keystrokes (<a href="http://www.creativekeystrokes.net">http://www.creativekeystrokes.net</a>)</li> <li>Official Drew athletic zip-up jackets purchased as part of participation in a sport</li> <li>Forest Green, White, or black V-neck Sweater or Cardigan Sweater</li> </ul> </li> <li>All other outerwear, including but not limited to jackets, vests, sweatshirts, hoodies and shooting shirts, should be stored during the school day. Official Drew outerwear is permitted if shirt collar and tie are visible.</li> </ul>	
Other	<ul> <li>Jeans Passes may be issued as a reward or incentive. Students with jeans passes are encouraged, but not required to wear a Drew spirit wear (t-shirt, jacket, sweatshirt, etc). Students may wear jeans, cargo pants or other appropriate style pants without holes or rips above the knee, but may not wear athletic shorts, leggings or tights. Students may also wear sneakers, but not flip-flops, slides or Crocs.</li> <li>When approved by the administration select team and spirit clothing may be allowed on particular school days. Organization/Club t-shirts cannot be worn in lieu of a shirt and tie unless explicit approval is given.</li> </ul>	
Uniform Schedule	<ul> <li>Monday and Wednesday - Blazer Day         <ul> <li>All students are required to wear their blazer, button up shirt, and tie</li> </ul> </li> <li>Tuesday and Thursday - Polo Day         <ul> <li>Students are permitted to wear their black polo or button up shirt and tie</li> </ul> </li> <li>Friday - Jeans passes (if applicable)         <ul> <li>Students with a jeans pass may dress down per the guidelines above. All other students must wear their black polo or white button down shirt and tie</li> </ul> </li> <li>accessories should be consistent with the formal and professional spirit of the uniform policy.</li> </ul>

- Head coverings are only allowed for religious reasons inside of the school building. (*Bandanas, scarves, bonnets, hats, etc. are not permitted*)
- Underwear, lingerie, bare cleavage, shoulders, midriffs, backs or hips should be covered at all times.

## \*Student Requested and Honored Uniform Change

Uniforms must be neat and clean and students should also practice good hygiene. The policy above applies to students as they enter the school building and throughout the school day. If a child is out of uniform, they may be required to secure appropriate attire <u>before attending class</u>.
