Family Pledge

We pledge to:

- 3. Notify the school of any potential exposures, symptoms, or positive COVID-19 test results in a timely manner as outlined in the school's protocols.
- 4. Have our student(s) screened when dropped off on campus.
- 5. Encourage our student(s) to practice social distancing and practice social distancing as a family whenever feasible.
- 6. Have our student(s) wear a face covering and wear face coverings as a family, particularly when social distancing is not possible or difficult.
- 7. Encourage our student(s) to commit to frequent hand-washing and sanitizing and commit to frequent hand-washing and sanitizing as a family.
- 8. Cooperate with local, state, and federal agencies in contact tracing efforts.
